Climate

The Trans Labrador Frontier Loop covers a large area of Labrador, temperatures and precipitation vary; it's best to prepare for both warm and cold weather. Happy Valley-Goose Bay is much warmer than the south coast near Mary's Harbour. Happy Valley-Goose Bay can reach into the 30'c range during the summer months, and Mary's Harbour, mid-high 20'c.
